

# **Regina Backyard Suites**

2021-2022 | Policy Research, Public Consultation, Digital Modelling

Known by various names such as backyard suites, laneway suites, garden suites, and more, these accessory detached units (ADUs) are becoming increasingly popular across Canada. Cities are now working to make this built form a possibility for their residents and homeowners.


Tasked with restarting the initiative since its pandemic pause, I advanced Regina's ADU program. After researching regulations across several canadian municipalities and referencing the City's successful pilot projects, I drafted regulations for an ultimate round of public consultation. The resulting feedback supported my recommendation to council to amend the by-law and permit Backyard Suties in residential zones across the city. Residents were no long constrained to requesting pilot projects in their neighbourhoods.



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# **Community Benefits Agreements**

2017 | Policy Research, Public Consultation

Together with colleagues, we set out to bring together best practices for public consultation on community benefits agreements (CBAs). As a rapidly developing area, Toronto needed to leverage CBAs to ensure places and neighbourhoods improved and benefited from the development they were experiencing. Councillors needed to know that they had their community's interests at heart when negotiating CBAs that eventually meant supporting and approving development.

We produced a report that highlighted success stories from Canada and the US. Our report summarized legislation, listed common CBA benefits, advised on coalition building, and outlined a consultation strategy. The report and accompanying booklet now inform Toronto policy and aid councillors and staff in their roles as representatives of the community.

# **Grey Spaces: Vaughan Mills**

2016 | Urban Sustainability, Landscape Ecology

Vaughan Mills is known as one of the largest shopping malls in Canada, spanning nearly 1.3 million square feet of retail space. It's massive size is surrounded by an equally, if not larger, parking lot. The excessive amount of grey infrastructure thus poses an environmental and ecological problem for the surrounding wildlife (such birds and insects), these include: no shelter, window collisions, and exacerbating the urban heat island effect.

The team proposes tiered interventions for the co-existence of the mall and wildlife, without interfering with the daily function of either.








# **Public Square Design**

2016 | Rendering, Modelmaking







# Malaparte at McPherson




Located on McPherson Avenue is a unique jog in road, a parking lot, and the crossroads of visible and invisible infrastructure. Studying Villa Malaparte in Italy and bringing its focus on viewsheds to the unique site was an exciting challenge. Noticing the crossroads of infrastructure (roads, railways, transmissions lines, and a plethora of buried pipes), I set out to daylight and draw on the buried pipes for the project's landscape and interior spaces. The massing is inspired by Villa Malaparte and seeks to emphasize the site's viewsheds to the south, railways and downtown.

















# **Mount Pearl Urban Forestry Plan**










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# Metrolinx Map
